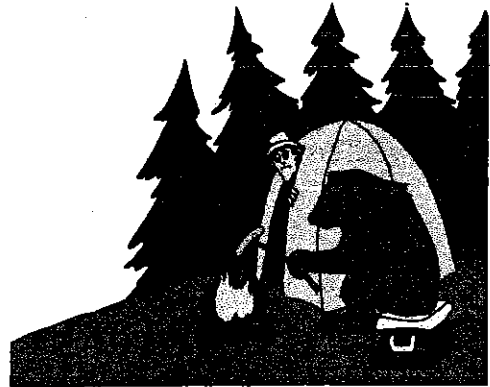
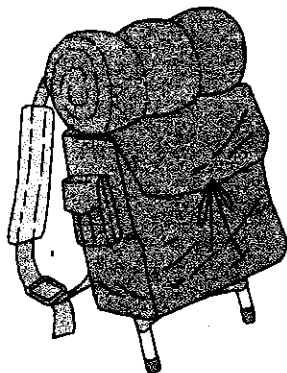

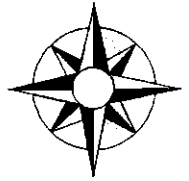
**Backpacking equipment list:**

  - Benedryl tablets**
  - Band-Aids**

- 20 feet of light cord (parachute cord)**

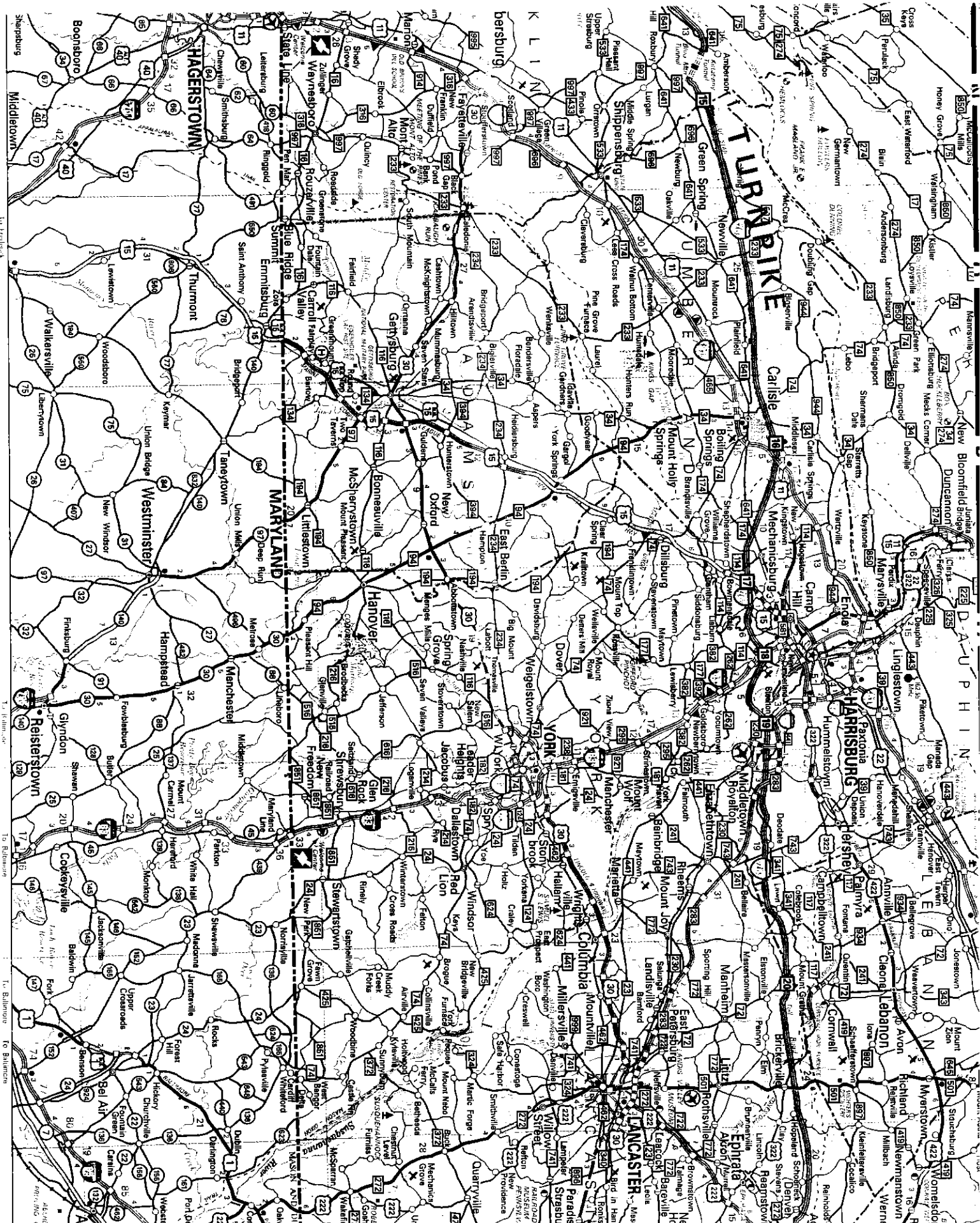

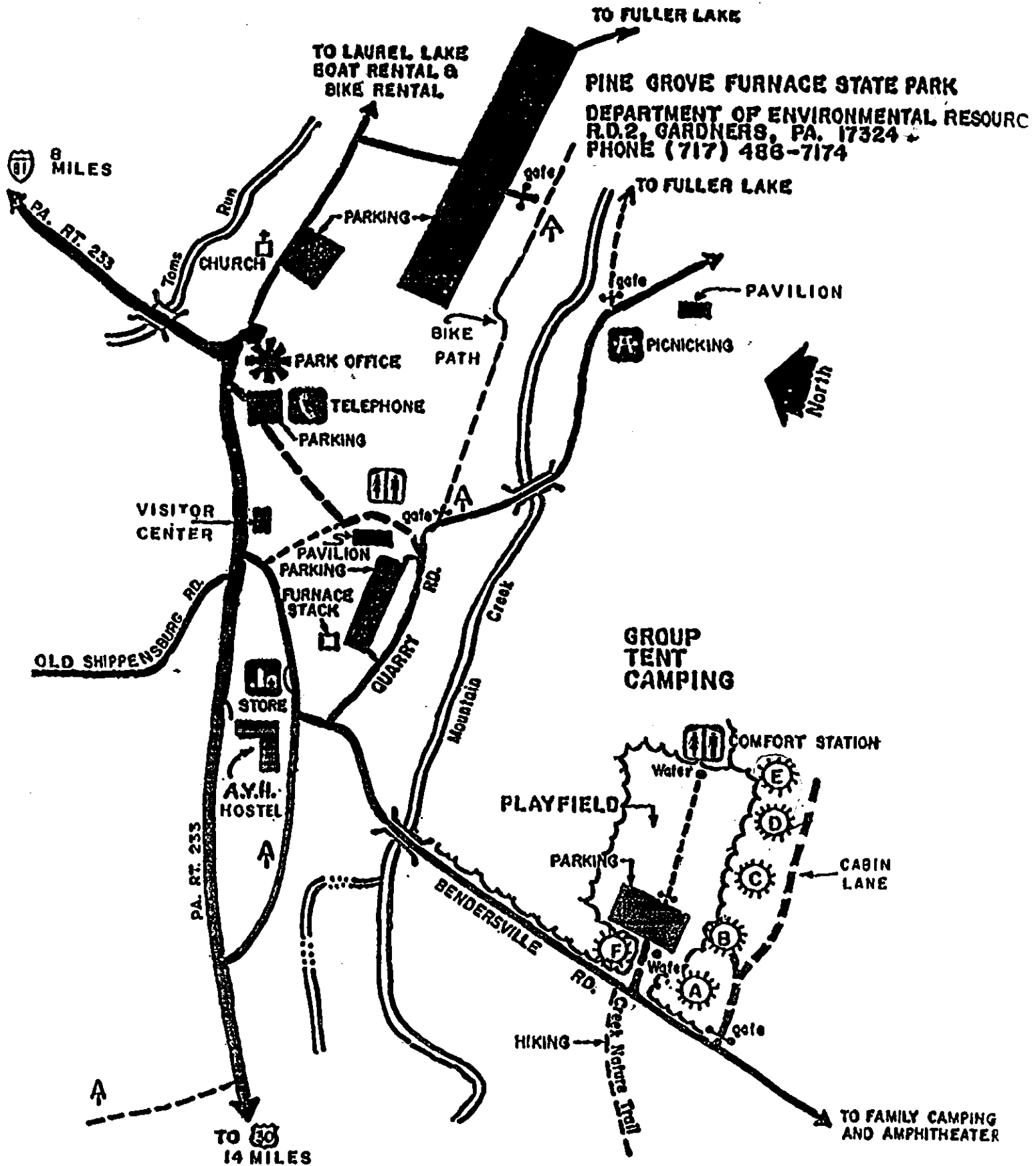
